



# Video Capture Tutorial / Interview rooms

- ⦿ The School of Medicine uses a camera system for teaching. Cameras and microphones are fitted to tutorial and interview rooms.
- ⦿ The cameras are always live. A red bulb by the camera glows when power is connected and flashes when it is recording.
- ⦿ The privacy protocols are contained in the data management section of the school handbook. Only a few teaching and IT support staff can view live cameras. The camera feed is not normally monitored however there is no absolute guarantee that the stream of data is completely protected. As a result no private or commercial business should be conducted in these rooms.

- ⦿ The School of Medicine uses a camera system to enhance teaching and assessment. Cameras and microphones are fitted to clinical skills rooms.
- ⦿ The cameras are always live. Beside each camera is a red bulb; this glows when power is connected and flashes when recording.
- ⦿ The privacy protocols are contained in the data protection section of the handbook. Only a few teaching and IT support staff can view live cameras however. The camera feed is not normally monitored however there is no absolute guarantee that the stream of data is completely protected. As a result no private or commercial business should be conducted in these rooms and for additional piece of mind during non-assessed practicals, users can log on and tilt the camera towards the ceiling if required.
