

Guidelines for PGR who wish to teach

1. The University policies outlined in the [“Doctoral students who teach”](#) must be followed.
2. Participants must complete all essential training courses.
3. Participants may assist with small group teaching, eg ethics, clinical skills, communication skills, multi-purpose lab, dissection room, according to background and expertise.
4. Participants may contribute to marking of formative pieces.
5. Doctoral students may not give lectures.
6. Doctoral students should not be the primary supervisor for MD4002 or similar project based work. They may assist with supervisory tasks with close oversight by the primary supervisor. They may not contribute to the marking of the work.
